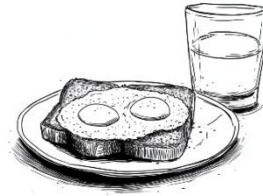

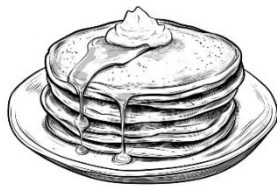

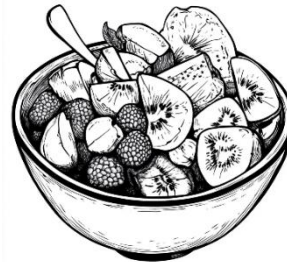

The Riverdale City Museum

Welcome to The Riverdale City Museum, a small and friendly place in the very center of Riverdale. This museum helps visitors explore the history of our town and discover how local people lived many years ago. You will find old photographs, documents, and everyday objects from the past. These items show the growth of Riverdale, from a small village to a lively city.

The museum is open to the public every day except Monday. On weekdays (Tuesday to Friday), it opens at 9 a.m. and closes at 5 p.m. On weekends (Saturday and Sunday), it is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tickets are affordable: adults pay £5 for one visit, and children under 14 pay £2. A special family ticket is available for £12 (two adults and up to two children under 14). Teenagers over 14 pay the adult ticket price, which is £5.

Next to the main entrance, there is a small café where you can buy hot drinks, cold drinks, sandwiches, and sweet pastries. It is open during museum hours and offers a relaxing spot for a quick break. The café walls display pictures of the old town, so visitors can see Riverdale in different periods of its history.

Every weekend, the museum organises children's workshops where kids can learn about old crafts, tools, and clothing. They can also create their own simple souvenirs. These workshops are free of charge, and parents are welcome to watch or explore the other exhibits. The museum staff members are always happy to answer questions about Riverdale's history or help you plan your visit.

If you want to learn more, you can join a guided tour every Saturday at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. The tour costs £3 for adults and £1 for children. You do not need to book ahead—just buy a ticket at the reception desk before it starts. Every month, the museum also prepares a new themed exhibition. You can check the museum's website to find out what topic is coming next.

We hope you enjoy your time at The Riverdale City Museum. Discover interesting facts about the people, places, and events that shaped our city, and share your own stories with our friendly staff!
